Year One Science IncurSION

It was delightful to see our Year 1 students participating in Science activities in the hall last Friday. Students were extremely engaged in making predictions, testing and observing the changes. Some students were asked to recount the incurSION –

On Friday we had a Science incurSION. We made some slimy, sticky slime. We also got to put some pencils through a plastic bag with water inside! Our teacher's name was Camille. I had an incredible time! **Jasmine 1C**
