### Assistant Principal's Report

And so we welcome Term 3! We have had a positive start to our term with students and teachers refreshed and eager for teaching and learning. Students have reflected on their goals from Parent/Teacher Interviews or 3 Way Conferences to enable them to make a positive start to their learning this term. Ask your children about what they found interesting today. What were they proud of and what was a challenge? Personal growth comes from extending oneself, questioning, investigating and assimilating that information. James Nottingham, U.K. Educational Consultant describes, 'Being in the pit' of learning for students is when they are at the heart of the Learning Challenge in a state of "cognitive conflict". That is to say when learners have two or more ideas that make sense to them but which on reflection, are in conflict with each other. Our Year 6 students will have demonstrated their growth mindset through their selected inquiries at the upcoming Year 6 Exhibition on August 7<sup>th</sup>. Unfortunately, I have to report that Gayle Yardley has been most unwell due to persistent symptoms from a fall she had last term that resulted in prolonged concussion and some damage to her recently repaired knee. She is on strict orders not to use 'screens' and rest although we are communicating by phone. Thank you to all the parents for their well wishes for Gayle's speedy recovery.

**Term 3 – Concert Term!** Term 3 means Concert Term at CSPS. We all look forward to our wonderful school concert at Robert Blackwood Hall, Monash University, Clayton campus. Julie Hoffman works closely with students to choreograph songs and dances and promotes the individual talents of students, encouraging individuals and groups to showcase their talents.

**Update Report on Toilets** Last Wednesday we met with the architect from Design Spaces, Andreas Tourogiannis, and the team from Modus Project who will be overseeing the renovation of the girls' and boys' toilets. This meeting was to discuss the logistics of creating a safe site for the students, teachers, community and the workers. As a school we will be required to share the space and be mindful of the workers requirements to 'go about their core job'. There will be approximately a 2 week turn around for permits to be processed and then the works will take from 6-7 weeks to complete.

**Parent Opinion Survey** The 2018 Department of Education Parent Opinion Survey is conducted this term. Parent input and opinion contributes greatly to a range of data that informs future planning and improvement, to make our school the best it can be. Parents from our community are randomly selected to participate in these annual surveys, which are confidential and anonymous. The 2018 Parent Opinion Survey will this year be completed online from the 23<sup>rd</sup> July to 26<sup>th</sup> August. The refreshed survey seeks parent opinions on measures of school climate, student engagement and effective teaching practice known to influence student engagement and student outcomes. A random sample of parents will be sent an email with the survey link this week. I strongly encourage parents to take the time to complete the survey. ### 40 Years Service Presentation Ceremony

On Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, Mrs Lorraine Schnall, CSPS Art Teacher, who is currently on long-service leave, received recognition for 40 years of dedicated service to teaching.

The recognition of service ceremony was held in the Great Hall at the National Gallery of Victoria and attended by the Deputy Premier and Minister for Education, the Honourable James Merlino MP.

## Teachers learning it's good to make mistakes in Maths!

Over the first week of Term 3, Adelaide based education consultant Kelvin Sparks worked with our teachers to help us improve our teaching of Mathematics. Our focus was to help students develop deeper meaning and rich understanding, moving away from a traditional process oriented approach. Our teachers had a couple of long days so that we could participate in after school learning sessions, where we looked at the rich learning encouraged by "low floor, high ceiling" maths tasks. We also talked about the power of adopting a growth mindset and the importance of making mistakes in our learning. Mr Sparks also met with all our teaching teams individually during their planning time and then modelled lessons with each year. "Mr Sparks encouraged me to do things in Maths that I hadn't done before" Tahlia H. "He showed us pictures of how your brain looks when you think you can do something, compared to what it looks like when you think you can't do it" Sasha M. "He was really encouraging. If we said we couldn't do something, he said we couldn't do it "YET" Toby G. "Mr Sparks showed us numbers in lots of different ways" Aiden S " and we noticed patterns that helped us understand multiples and fractions better" Jayden E. "We normally talk about numbers and stuff in maths but with him it was more about thinking" Jason A.

We would like to thank our staff and students for all of their hard work with Mr Sparks last week. We also thank Mr Sparks for sharing his time, expertise and enthusiasm for Mathematics with us.







We hope everyone is as excited as the Camp Australia team for the second half of the year and all the fun that is in store, especially at outside school hours care!

I would like to introduce myself, my name is Lucy. I am the new Coordinator at Caulfield South Primary School Outside School Hour Care program. I'm currently completing a Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care.

I have a background in social work, previously working with children in out of home care and have also worked as an aide in Primary schools with a focus on children's wellbeing. I absolutely love working with children, teaching them new skills and having the privilege of seeing them learn and grow.

I like to spend time with my friends and family, I am a proud mother of a one-year old boy and he certainly likes to keep me busy. I love travelling and learning about other cultures, going to the footy (Go Swans!). I also have a passion for arts and crafts and can't wait to see what the kids will create at OSHC.

Unfortunately, David Brown (recently returned Coordinator) was unable to continue in the role due to personal circumstances. We understand his return was well received yet short lived. We wish David the best of luck for the future

The program continues to be supported by myself and the other long term assistants - Salah, Steph, Eddin, Rehka.

We're here to make your children's experience the best possible, if you have any feedback or questions about the program – feel free to drop by, meet the team, and see what happens in Outside School Hours Care first hand.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> of July 2018, the Government's new Child Care Package was launched – replacing the previous Child Care Rebate (CCR) and Child Care Benefit (CCB) with a single **Child Care Subsidy (CCS)**.

This new subsidy is available to all families using Camp Australia services, and may affect the amount of fee assistance that each family will receive.

#### **Three things will determine a family's level of Child Care Subsidy:**

- **Annual income** will determine the percentage of subsidy a family is eligible for,
- An **activity test** will determine how many hours of subsidised care families can access, and
- **The type** of child care service will determine the hourly rate cap (for OSHC this is \$10.29).

Since the release of CCS, we have found an outstanding number of parents who still have not confirmed their enrolment. We have sent several emails, text messages and school newsletters to make sure they understand that if they do not confirm their enrolment on the MyGov website they may be paying more for care than they need to be.

With the roll out of the new CCS, **Additional Child Care Subsidy (ACCS)** is replacing Special CCB.

What this means for parents and how you can help:

- Parents who are eligible to receive **Additional Child Care Subsidy (ACCS)** under the **Temporary Financial Hardship** category will need to submit a claim on the Centrelink website directly.
- If a child has been identified as being at risk of serious abuse or neglect, we can consider an **ACCS (Child Wellbeing)** claim for them. You will need to provide to your school's Key Account Manager a letter of support, which includes as much information regarding the child's circumstance, if known the details of the agency or referral body and inform the parent that we will contact them to follow up on their claim within the next week. Should the new CCS create any hardship for parents, we can organise a payment plan to help parents navigate through this challenging time. They will need to contact our Customer Care team to get this arranged.

Any parent enquiries regarding CCS, contact Centrelink directly or alternatively, a brochure is available outside the School Office administration area. If you have any other concerns, please do not hesitate to contact our Customer Care team on 1300 105 343. The team are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (except National Public Holidays).


