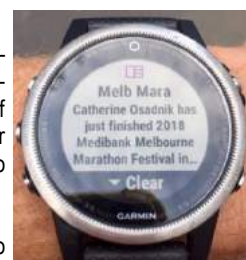


### Welcome to Term 4!

### Professional Development @ CSPS

Last Thursday, Caulfield South Primary School had another visit from education consultant, Adam Voigt. Adam spent his time in classes, both modelling teaching strategies for teachers and observing teachers and giving feedback. He worked with our single subject specialist teachers during the morning and different groups of classroom teachers throughout the rest of the day. There was some very positive learning for both staff and students from Adam's visit. Ben N in 5C loved the writing activity that his class completed, where they used Bohemian Rhapsody as a prompt to create a narrative text. Students in 4B discussed different strategies that teachers can use to solve classroom problems. Zach S said that creating a play to demonstrate his understanding of this was a really fun way to learn. Caulfield South Primary is very appreciative of the ongoing work of Adam Voigt in areas such as restorative classrooms and student engagement which has been consolidated over the last three years.

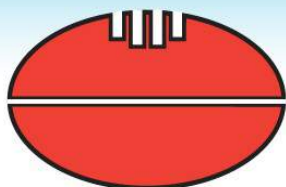
