Electronic Kiosk to Replace Late Arrivals/Early Departures Sign in and Out Book

In our ongoing attempts to improve the efficiency of school processes, we will trial using an electronic kiosk to replace our manual "sign and and sign out" book for late arrivals and early departures. To begin with, an iPad will be located in the school office displaying the "Attendance Kiosk" function of our Sentral school management software.

The Attendance Kiosk automatically links with teacher's electronic rolls, helping ensure teachers, families and school administration are accurately informed as to each students whereabouts.

This year's introduction of electronic roll marking has highlighted a significant number of students arriving late to school, often without a parent or guardian present to explain the late arrival. This is having a significant impact on teacher's ability to ensure smooth transition to learning each morning.

In an effort to combat this, the attendance kiosk has been set up as follows:

If you arrive with your child and wish to explain the late arrival (e.g you've come from a medical appointment) one of the CSPS office staff will need to authorise the explanation as you enter it on the kiosk

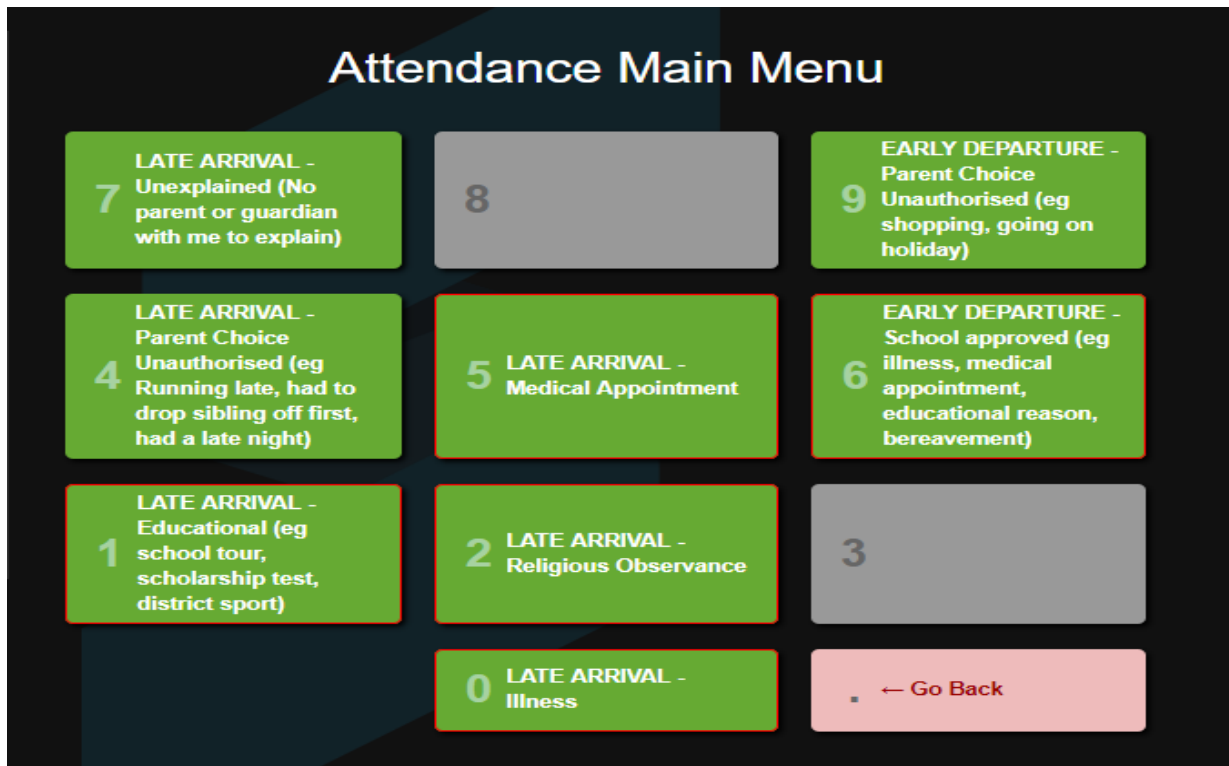
Students arriving late without a parent or guardian present will only be able to select the options "LATE ARRIVAL - Unexplained" or "LATE ARRIVAL - Parent Choice Unauthorised" (*If you wish to explain late arrival, but you are not able to be present to sign your child in, you will need to email the school - preferably before the late arrival*)

Explanations for late arrival - such as slept in, had to drop a sibling off first, had a late night or couldn't find a park - are not considered adequate by government regulations and will be marked as "Parent Choice - Unauthorised"

Early departures will also be recorded using the Attendance Kiosk

Students will still need to take a yellow "Late Pass" with them to class, and parents wishing to collect their child early from school will still need to collect the laminated strip from the office.

As this is a trail, CSPS staff will be present to guide you through the process and written instructions will also be visible next to the kiosk. Obviously, we welcome feedback on the process.

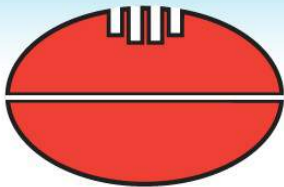
