ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT—Gill Bartholomeusz

Drum Corps—Over the weekend our Drum Corps had the opportunity to be part of the Remembrance Day Parade at the Shrine of Remembrance. With the dedicated guidance and organisation of Mr Sandy Hood, their performance made us all very proud.

Not only was it another wonderful public performance opportunity for the Corps, it was also an opportunity to participate in a significant ceremony of community recognition of this day. This year was particularly special as 11th November 2018 marked the 100th anniversary of the Armistice which ended the First World War.

2019 Prep Transition

We will have 3 Prep classes in 2019 and most of these children have attended the first three transition sessions which is terrific. It's been a pleasure for Gayle, Kelly (our Prep Transition Coordinator) and I to welcome new families to our school. While we have given the parents information about our school, the current Prep teachers have provided the children with activities to introduce them to school and assist with a smooth transition. I'd like to thank our Prep teachers as well as our Yr 6 students who have, in their leadership capacity, welcomed the new families upon arrival at CSPS and the Yr 4 students who will be 'buddies' to the new Preps. The last session will be held at 2.30pm next Thursday 22nd November '18.

Class Placements 2019

We have now received much parent input which will be taken into account as we plan classes for next year. Teachers now work together in their teams, taking children and parent input into consideration, along with their comprehensive knowledge of students and the academic, social, emotional and behavioural needs of the cohort, in an endeavour to ensure children are well placed for optimal learning, while also taking into account the social and emotional aspects involved. Gayle and I also contribute our knowledge from another perspective which sometimes includes confidential information that may need to be considered. I would like parents to understand the time and consideration that is put into this future planning and to realise it is therefore, not possible to accept late requests for input because of the complexities and time required for this process. **In consideration of the importance of this process, it is most important that parents advise us of any students leaving the school in 2019 so that we may take that into consideration when placing children in their new grades.**

Family Life Sessions We had a great turnout of families at Tuesday night's Family Life Sessions held in the Hall. Three sessions were held to cater for all ages and covered the following topics—Body Basics (Yr1&2), Where Did I Come From (Yr 3&4) and Preparing for Puberty (Yr 5&6). These sessions are run by Interrelate (Family Life of Victoria) and 40,000 young people and their families participate in the programs each year. Thank you to Zoe Whitaker and Avril Steier for coordinating these very informative sessions this year.

Helper's Thank You We will soon be sending home 'Thank You' Invitations to invite the many parents who have supported teachers, programs and students over the last 12 months. It has been greatly appreciated by the staff and students. You will be invited to join us on Wednesday 28th November from 8.30am—9am in the hall for light refreshments. I look forward to seeing many of our school community at the Fiesta to be held at CSPS on Saturday 24th November '18. There will be market stalls, a Sausage Sizzle a Coffee Cart and lots for the children to do. This is a wonderful fundraiser for our school and our PA have been busy organising to make this a very special event.

Sentral Update: Health module replacing first aid "Pink Slips"


The school has started using the Health module within our Sentral school management computer system to record first aid incidents. As a result, the pink slips you have received in the past will be replaced by a slip printed from the Health module. The slip is automatically generated by Sentral and only includes the key information recorded into the system. As is currently the case, you will be contacted by phone if the incident requires more urgent communication.

Furthermore, a feature of the Sentral system is the ability to text parents with details of, or directions for action regarding a first aid incident. The school will only use the text feature if we have been unable to make contact via a phone call. It is hoped the text feature will help us avoid the games of "phone tag" that often occur after voice message is left. If your contact details need updating, please notify the school office.

Thursday 1st November 2018




