The Parent Payments consist of:

A: ESSENTIAL STUDENT LEARNING ITEMS (see attached for breakdown of fees)

Includes:

- **Booklist** items of which students take possession, including text books and student stationery
- **Consumable materials and non-consumable materials for Learning and Teaching** which students take possession of during Numeracy, Literacy, Music, Italian, Science, Art, Library and Technology. This will include online subscriptions, such as Seesaw and Essential Assessment, educational Apps, food and craft materials.

B: OPTIONAL ITEMS

Physical Education- A 5 day swimming program to develop knowledge and skills relating to survival swimming and basic water safety to reduce a child's drowning risk and enhance community safety.

Sport Levy includes costs associated with Interschool Sport, the Lightning Premiership and the Athletics Carnival.

Excursions/Incursions: These payments cover out of school excursions, camps, Year Level In-Visits, In-House Performances by visiting artists, Expert in Residence programs, and student well-being programs.

Excursions, In-House Performance payments and camps will be itemised and charged separately throughout the year.

Please note that students are strongly encouraged to attend Year 3-6 camps, Year 2 sleepover or Yr 1 dinner to foster independence, risk-taking and confidence.

Extra-curricular activities: These are provided on a user-pay basis. If you choose to access them for your child, you will be required to pay and you will be invoiced separately by the provider for these. These items may include:

Music Soccer Basketball Tennis Chess Hebrew Language Jewish Religious Studies

Other Optional items include:

Resource/Maintenance Contribution / Health and Wellbeing First Aid Officer Contribution

- Class sets of texts and other resources
- Health & Wellbeing-School First Aid Officer (Mon-Fri)
- Maintaining communal green spaces/ School Groundsman
- Library Resources
- Maintenance of air conditioners etc.
- Science, sport and technology equipment
- Music equipment

C: VOLUNTARY FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Parents are encouraged to make a voluntary contribution to support C.S.P.S. The General Fund Donation may be for general or clearly explained specific purposes that relate to the school council's functions and objectives. Parents will receive a separate receipt for their donation.
