PYP Evaluation Visit

Last week Caulfield South Primary completed the last stage of our PYP Evaluation – 'The Evaluation Visit'. Most of the parents and students at Caulfield South were involved in earlier stages of the Evaluation, by completing feedback surveys and participating in focus groups. By collecting feedback from the school community, and going through the Evaluation Visit by the visiting PYP team, Shane Paterson; Principal of Golden Grove Lutheran Primary School, Adelaide and Karen McCulloch; PYP Coordinator of Woodcroft College, Adelaide, the school has been gathering data to inform the strategic direction and goals of the school for the next five years. This rigorous and comprehensive process aimed to identify areas of strength in the school, as well as areas for future development.

The school will be issued with a thorough Evaluation Report in the coming months, which will go through the results of the Evaluation in detail. A summary of this report will then be given to the school community. At this stage we have received some very preliminary feedback from the Evaluation team, indicating that they were immensely pleased with the progress the school has made over the course of the last five years and the commitment demonstrated by the students, parents and staff of CSPS.

We would like to thank the whole school community for their participation and support during our Evaluation. The positive feedback that the school received is a testament to the ongoing efforts of all members of the school community. We also extend our sincere thanks to the visiting team who came all the way from Adelaide, taking time away from their families and schools, in order to help our school complete our Evaluation.

Thanks also go to Andy McKibbin and Andy Stefaniak, our PYP Coordinators, who have guided the whole school through the Evaluation process.
